HAN Tourism Conference "Unlocking new Horizons"

During February, OMD 2030 was invited to give a presentation at the Hospitality Association of Namibia (HAN) conference that was held in Lüderitz.

The theme of the conference "Unlocking new Horizons" was chosen to celebrate the opening-up of the previously forbidden 'Sperrgebiet' area and to tell the story of tourism in the far south of Namibia to date.

The Sperrgebiet, is now part of the Tsau //Khaeb (Sperrgebiet) National Park, (TKNP) an area previously reserved for diamond mining and accessible only to the lucky few. The first TKNP tourism concessions were awarded by the Ministry of Environment, Fisheries and Tourism at the end of 2021, and these will allow visitors to experience this magnificent, unique wilderness, steeped in history.

The OMD 2030 presentation entitled "Tourism's full circle in //kharas: Linking Mining Towns" described the Oranjemunnd tourism journey of recent years; our successes, the obstacles we face, and our vision for the future (Go to: https://youtu.be/WkcWyesCrgo) for more information.

Our story was well received by the delegates, and the resultant important contacts that were made during the remainder of the conference, and the spectacular Gala Dinner, held the in Kolmanskop ghost town, will be important to ensure the continued progress of tourism in Oranjemund.
